

### CONFERENCES

SANDIEGOCA/SEPT 3 & 4 / 2010 Conversations

Friday, September 3. Art & Money Conversations offers attendees of the fair access to first-hand information on aspects of art collecting by facilitating direct encounters between leading personalities of the international art world. It is a forum that encourages the exchange of ideas through a series of platform discussions. Conversations will focus on the collection and the acquisition of art. Distinguished art collectors, curators, gallery owners, publishers, artists will take part.



Saturday, September 4. A one-day conference focused on determining how the most transformative arts and culture initiatives nationwide can be implemented in San Diego. The program will be moderated by **David Malmuth**, a noted entertainment developer who is responsible for the rebirth of The New Amsterdam Theater in NYC and the Kodak Theater in Hollywood. Confirmed speakers at this time include Tim Jones who leads Artscape in Toronto, an international developer of artist live/work spaces and Aaron Paley, President of **CARSLA**, an innovator in creating performance in public spaces.

**ART COLLECTORS** Want to build the art collection of your dreams? With art critic **Jori Finkel** acting as coach, **BOOT CAMP** you can spend up to \$50,000 (of play money, sorry!) on works from the fair to assemble your own visionary art collection. The workshop will begin with Finkel's introduction to various buying strategies and end with a group presentation of your new acquisitions. Along the way, you will visit several of the gallery booths at the fair and discover more about your own identity as a collector.

LATIN CINEMATHEQUE ART SAN DIEGO is pleased to present Latin Cinematheque, a screening space created specifically inside the fair to showcase cutting-edge films. Co-presented by Media Arts Center and the San Diego Latino Film Festival, and hosted by Yolanda S. Walther-Meade. The lead feature will be "EL Informe Toledo" a fascinating film directed by Albino Alvarez and will be featured several times a day. The documentary explores the series of fifteen prints Francisco Toledo made in response to Franz Kafka's "Report for an Academy".

CONCURRENT ART SAN DIEGO programs will spread throughout the city of San Diego and into Tijuana CITY-WIDE with collaborative events and ART LABS. Included will be spaces in Barrio Logan (Device PROGRAMMING Gallery/Sanctuary Space/Glashaus), Sushi Performance & Visual Arts, L Street Fine Art Gallery, Patricia Rincon Dance Collective "Blurred Borders," Westfield Shopping Center, San Diego International Airport, La Casa del Tunel Art Center in Tijuana, along with five dedicated public outdoor spaces featuring large scale, multi-artist, multi-site exhibitions.
